

# **The Rock, Easter – Teddy Bears Picnic 2026**

For the comfort and enjoyment of all our participants we ask all visitors to adhere to the simple rules of play:

## **Parents and guardians MUST:**

- Remain on the premises at all times.
- Monitor their child to ensure he/she is capable of using the equipment safely.
- Know where their child is at all times and ensure their child can locate them at all times.
- Parents and guardians know their own child's capabilities, so they should ensure an appropriate level of supervision to reflect this. For the safety of the other children, The Rock reserve the right to remove unruly children from the activity area.

## **General Rules:**

- All children must be always accompanied by a responsible adult. The Rock does not accept responsibility for the supervision of children.
- Holiday clubs or large groups are not permitted to take part due to the limited capacity available for each session.
- Jewellery and badges should be removed and kept safe by a responsible adult.
- Spectacles should only be worn if used with a retainer and shatter proof lenses. The Rock cannot be held responsible for the damage or loss of such articles
- We recommend the activities are suitable for children between the ages of 3 - 12 years old
- No sharp objects may be taken into the play area.
- No food or drink or chewing gum should be taken into the play area.

- It is not recommended that children who feel unwell are allowed to enter the play area.
- Fighting or bullying will not be tolerated. Guilty parties may be asked to leave.
- Report all accidents to a member of staff.
- All damage to the playground area either accidental or deliberate must be reported to a member of staff.

The Rock event team supervise the use of the equipment to maximise the fun and entertainment of your children however they are not a replacement for parental supervision. While every consideration has been given for the safety of the children using the play area, we cannot be held responsible for accidents which occur because of children playing on the equipment.
