Rules of Play

For the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all participants, we ask that all visitors follow these simple rules.

Parents and Guardians MUST:

- Remain on the premises at all times.
- Supervise and monitor their child throughout the session to ensure they are playing safely and behaving appropriately.
- Ensure children follow all instructions given by members of The Rock Potting Shed team.
- Inform a member of staff of any medical conditions or additional needs that may affect their child's participation.

General Rules

- All children must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. The Rock does not accept responsibility for the supervision of children.
- Holiday clubs, childcare providers and large organised groups are not permitted to participate due to the limited capacity available for each session.
- Activities are recommended for children aged 3–12 years.
- No sharp objects or dangerous items may be brought into the Potting Shed area.
- Food, drinks and chewing gum are not permitted inside the Potting Shed.
- Children who are feeling unwell or showing symptoms of illness should not take part.
- Please respect the equipment, facilities and other participants.
- All accidents, injuries or damaged equipment must be reported immediately to a member of staff.
- Please follow all instructions given by The Rock Potting Shed team.

Important Information

The Rock Potting Shed team are present to facilitate activities and maximise the fun and enjoyment of your visit. They are **not** a replacement for parental or guardian supervision.

Whilst every reasonable precaution has been taken to provide a safe play environment, participation is at your own risk. The Rock cannot accept liability for accidents or incidents arising from failure to follow these rules, misuse of the equipment, or a lack of appropriate parental supervision.
